weakened frame



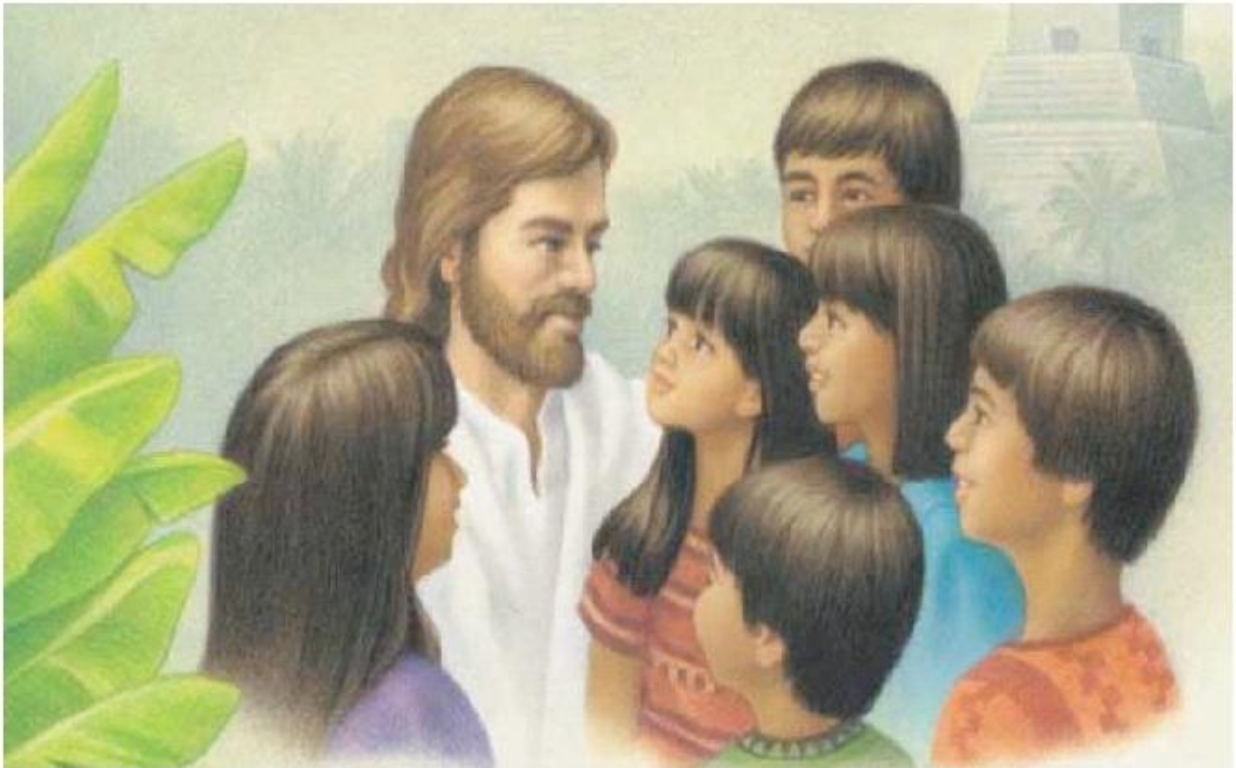
she stretched forth her

A boy stood with the Nephites



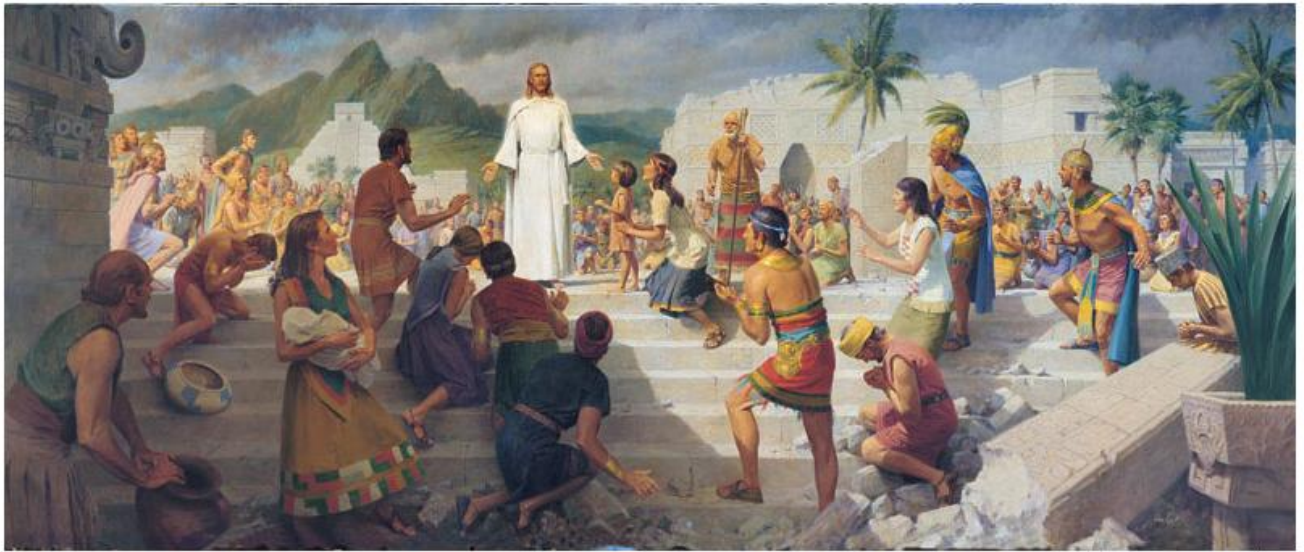
at the city temple walls.

them all.

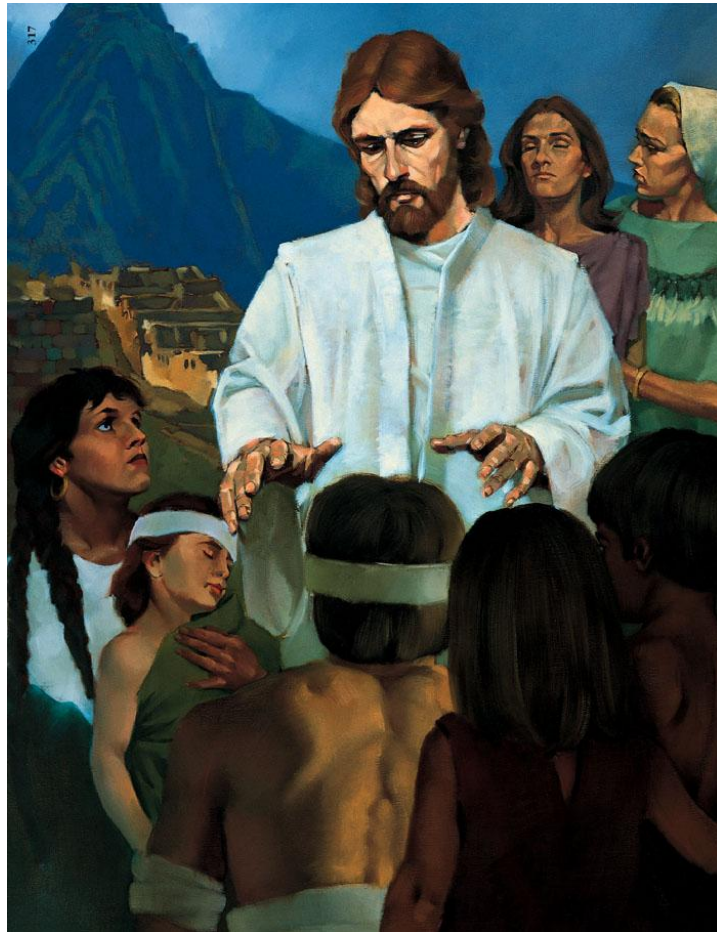
Then Jesus called the
